Domtar Dryden Forestlands establishes mandatory behaviours and expectations concerning the environment for all its employees, contractors and overlapping license holders. These are based on Domtar's Corporate policies, namely:

- Environmental Policy
- Forest Policy
- Fibre Use and Sourcing Policy

These Corporate policies summarize three key core principles that transcend to all Domtar Dryden Forestlands activities:

- **C**ontinuously improve
- **O**bey the law
- **P**rotect the environment

These commit the Forestlands team to legislative compliance, sustainable forest practices, forest stewardship, ensuring safe workplaces, respecting aboriginal and treaty rights, a commitment to independent third party forest certification and continual improvement of the environmental performance. Forest management planning and operations are guided by the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry through the forest management planning process.
